- **Necklace—*Colors of the Salish World***—The cold lapis blue of deep water in sunshine, shimmering gray of rocks in the midday heat, spring's brazen green of conifers...
- **An Afternoon at the Cousins Farm with music by Kip & Stanley Greenthal (up to 25 people)**—Begin your afternoon with a tour of the historic Cousins farm—explore the classic barn, flowers & heirloom fruit trees, and read some of the secret notes Willie Cousins hid around the farm. Then, enjoy delicious refreshments by Mary Jenison & Raiti Waerness while you listen to an afternoon concert of Kip & Stanley Greenthal's timeless music.
- **1908 & 1910 Eagle \$10 gold coins**—President Theodore Roosevelt thought American coins were poorly designed, so he chose America's foremost sculptor, Augustus St. Gaudens to craft these coins. The coins each contain half an ounce of gold, and have a significant premium for numismatic value.
- **Sailing Adventure on the Tern for 6**—Leave Hunter Bay in the beautifully hand-built Tern, and sail to a delicious meal at an idyllic beach location.
